August - A Month of Gratitude, Remembrance, and Renewal

August invites us to pause, reflect, and celebrate significant milestones of faith, history, humanity's enduring spirit.

We honour the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary(August 15), a sacred celebration of hope, purity, and the promise of eternal life. Across the globe, many nations mark their independence milestones this month, reminding us of the sacrifices made for freedom and our ongoing responsibility to safeguard it. We also observe International Youth Day(August 12), affirming the vital role of young people as the dreamers and builders of a better tomorrow.

In Sri Lanka, August is rich with religious and cultural significance. Key events include the majestic Esala Perahera in Kandy, honoring the Sacred Tooth Relic of the Buddha; Nikini Full Moon Poya Day, marking the first Buddhist council and the start of the monks' retreat; and the Madhu Church Annual Festival on August 15, drawing thousands to celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary—a feast also observed in Catholic parishes nationwide.

August also calls us to remember two martyrs of Auschwitz: St. Maximilian Kolbe and St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. Their heroic witness challenges us to pray fervently that such inhumanity never be repeated. ### The Priests' Chapel





This is the Priests' Chapel, located on the first floor of the College Church building, centered around the Blessed Sacrament in a monstrance displayed on the altar for adoration.

The altar, covered with a white cloth, features a golden, radiant monstrance at its center, flanked by red decorative panels that draw the eye toward the Eucharist. On the left stands a statue of St. Joseph holding the Child Jesus, and on the right, a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary also holding the Child Jesus. A lamp burns, symbolizing the presence of Christ.



Behind the altar, a stained-glass image of Jesus with outstretched arms serves as a backdrop. Above it, a vivid mural by Mr. Dinesh Buddhika depicts the Holy Trinity: God the Father at the top center, the Holy Spirit as a dove below Him, and Jesus crucified in the middle. Angels surround the scene, with Moses holding the Ten Commandments on one side and St. Peter holding the key given to him by Jesus on the other.


All the sacred articles in this chapel are generous donations from the parish and people of Our Lady Help of Christians Church, Staten Island, New York.
